

Ed Bruemmer Memorial Trophy

The St. Louis Herding Club has established the Ed Bruemmer Memorial Trophy to honor one of the first members of our club. Ed was always there to pitch in whenever help was needed. He worked very hard with his dogs, frequently rescued Australian Cattle Dogs.

The Ed Bruemmer Memorial Trophy is a traveling trophy. It will be awarded at the SLHC Christmas party each year, to the St. Louis Herding Club member/dog team who have acquired the most points over a 12 month period from November 1 until October 31.

The points will be awarded at all St. Louis Herding Club Sponsored Trials, regardless of the sanctioning body, according to the following schedule:

High In Trial	10 Points
Reserve High In Trial	9 Points
First Place In Any Class	7 Points
Second Place In Any Class	6 Points
Third Place In Any Class	5 Points
Fourth Place In Any Class	4 Points
Fifth Place (If awarded)	3 Points
Qualifying Score	1 Point

The names of the winning handler/dog team will be engraved on a brass plate that will be attached to the trophy. The winning handler/dog team will receive a plaque indicating that they are the winners for that year.

The trophy will be displayed at all SLHC trials, and its disposition, when not on display, will be the responsibility of the Trophy Chairman.

If the trophy is won by the same member five times (with the same dog or multiple dogs), the trophy will be retired, and the trophy will remain in the permanent possession of that member.
